Already struggling with the rising fuel, energy and food prices, the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war is now threatening to deepen the crisis for the poorest households, pulling millions more into financial trouble. Despite all this, the boom in the UK property market is not cooling down.

As per the recent **Halifax House Price Index report**, the average house price increased for the 11th consecutive month – up to 12.6%, whilst the **Office for National Statistics** revealed that the cost of renting in the United Kingdom increased by 2% in 2021, the biggest yearly increase since 2007.
